What is the Diabetes Research Network?

The Diabetes Research Network is funded by the Department of Health and is part of the UK Clinical Research Network, which is developing support for research in a range of conditions.

The Diabetes Research Network aims to improve the coordination and quality of diabetes research across the UK by:

- Creating a more effective research environment to improve diabetes care
- Ensuring that the research we do is relevant to the needs of those affected by diabetes.

We are developing a range of studies to improve prevention, diagnosis, care and treatment for people with diabetes, or those at risk of developing it.

What we have achieved so far in Torbay?

As a multi-disciplinary team (Doctors, Nurses, and a range of other health professionals) we have researched practical issues of living with diabetes. These have included dietary and lifestyle advice, home glucose monitoring, education/support groups at diagnosis, implications of the effects of diabetes on feet, eyes and blood vessels.

We have collaborated with the Oxford University Trials Unit in the UKPDS (the largest trial ever undertaken of type 2 diabetes and its management) and other multicentre trials.

- Medication and lifestyle advice for people with borderline raised sugars (not yet with diabetes)
- Study of the effects of medication on blood fats and circulation
- New treatments in diabetes
- Exploration of genetics of diabetes
