## FLEXIBLE SIGMOIDOSCOPY (No Sedation)

- **1.** You may resume your usual diet and drink as normal.
- 2. You may resume your normal activities as soon as you feel comfortable to do so.
- **3.** You may experience a little bloating with wind pains or spots of blood, this is normal and usually settles quite quickly.

N.B. If you experience <u>severe</u> pain in your lower abdomen you should return to the Hospital Accident and Emergency Department. Any other nonurgent concerns can be made through the Endoscopy Unit on:
