What is Teicoplanin?

Teicoplanin is an antibiotic of the glycopeptides type which is used to fight infection.

How to take Teicoplanin?

Teicoplanin is always given by injection.

You will be given your injection daily.

It is important that you are given your injection every day for as long as your doctor has said is necessary, otherwise the infection may return.

Undesirable effects

Most people do not have any unwanted effects, but there may rarely be problems.

Report immediately to your MAAT Nurse any allergic reactions including rash, itch, redness of the skin and shortness of breath.

Contact your MAAT nurse if you develop any persistent diarrhoea, nausea or vomiting, dizziness or headache, hearing problems, ringing in the ears or feeling off balance or if you notice any side effects not listed on this sheet.
