- ♦ Hearing aid (if used)
- ♦ Your walking aid i.e. a frame or stick
- Door key (the care home can keep this in a safe for you)
- Name and contact numbers of relatives or friends
- Something to keep you amused such as a book or magazine
- Please do not bring any valuables with you other than some small change

If you have an existing package of care from the Care Trust, this will be placed 'on-hold' whilst you are in placement.
