Following your child's discharge from the Short Stay Paediatric Assessment Unit, his or her GP will be sent an electronic copy of your child's discharge paperwork. Specific advice relevant to your child's needs and care will be provided by our team.

Sharing information

We routinely share information with other healthcare professionals, such as health visitors, school nurses and social care, where appropriate. If you have any questions or concerns about the sharing of your child's information, please speak to the nurse in charge.
