

A podiatrist is a person who helps you look after your feet

When you arrive a podiatrist will talk to you and ask you some questions.

The podiatrist will check your blood pressure


The podiatrist will give you two injections to make your toe go to sleep

Lie comfortably and listento the music.



The podiatrist will fix your sore toe

A bandage will be put on your toe



It will take 1 or 2 months for your toe to get better



You need to put a clean dressing on your toe every day



Don't get your toe wet!



You can use a special sock to keep it dry when you wash
