The Macmillan Speech & Language Therapist (SLT) is part of the Head and Neck Oncology Multi-Disciplinary team at Torbay Hospital involved in your care.

The SLT can be available to meet you at your initial visit to the H&N Oncology Clinic to briefly explain their role in your care.

The SLT will meet you with the Head & Neck Support Team (made up of Clinical Nurse Specialist [CNS], SLT and Dietitian [RD]) in the Pre-Treatment Clinic. The SLT aim is to give you an explanation of how your communication and/or swallowing will be affected by the planned surgery, and answer any queries or concerns you may have.

The SLT will:

- Compare the normal anatomy with post-operative anatomy and explain what this means;
- explain post-operative speech and swallow;
- assess current function;
- identify need for pre-surgery therapy;
- arrange for you to meet another person who has undergone the same surgery, if you wish:
- provide written information.

The SLT will meet you post-surgery to:

- look at communication options;
- provide patient and family support;
- reiterate plans for rehabilitation;
- engage in teaching (jointly with CNS) cleaning, humidification, etc.;
- provide support through any further treatment, such as radiotherapy.

The SLT will provide regular followup and support, as required.

The SLT will introduce you to our patient-organised support group based at Torbay Hospital
