Hospital requested blood test

Your hospital doctor has asked
you to arrange a blood test

Important information about your blood test request

We are introducing a new electronic patient record system called *Epic*. This means the way hospital blood tests are requested is changing.

Your GP surgery is not currently connected to this system. However, you can still choose to have your blood test at your local GP practice.

To do this, please book your appointment with your GP surgery in the usual way. After your hospital appointment, you will be sent pre-printed labels in the post. Please take these labels with you to your blood test appointment, as they are needed to process your test.

There are several ways to have your blood test. More information about your options is included in this leaflet.

If you have received any paper forms before, talk to your doctor or nurse to see if you still need to use them.

What can I do?

You have several options for getting a blood test:

Your GP Practice

You can arrange an appointment at your local GP practice for your blood test.

However, if your GP Surgery is one of the following, please arrange for your blood test at Torbay Hospital, Brixham Hospital (if you live in that area) or the CDC.
