

# What is the "Planning for your Future Care" booklet

The booklet aims to help you plan for the future with the professionals involved in your care and the people who matter to you, whether they are carers or friends and family.

# There are five main parts to the booklet:

- a statement of your wishes and care preferences
- advance decision making
- putting your affairs in order
- making a will
- funeral planning

The booklet can help you to be supported in the way you wish, when you are unable to express your views for yourself. By recording your preferences in the booklet it will help ensure your wishes are taken into account.

The booklet can be added to over a period of time to meet your changing needs - if something is important to you, you can record it in the booklet. You don't need to fill in every section.

Whilst the booklet is associated with end of life care anyone can use the booklet, even if they do not have a specific health condition - the idea is that everyone should be thinking about planning how they would like to be cared for in the future.
