Introduction

This information sheet provides information about private day care services provided by care homes and day centres in Torbay. Where prices are shown these are for privately funded day care, but help with funding may be available, based on a means test, if you are eligible for social care support or your carer has 'enhanced' eligibility for a break. Torbay Adult Social Care is on (01803) 219700.

Please note that only services that provide **care** are included in this sheet. For details of services that offer leisure opportunities but no care, eg. lunch clubs and leisure centres, see our 'Leisure' information sheet (P28).

About the Listings

There are two charts at the beginning of this information sheet: one showing the various care services provided by each of the day care providers, and the other listing leisure services. These charts are followed by records of services, giving contact details and further information, such as times and whether transport is provided.

If you or someone you care for is thinking about using a day care service it is important to go along to try out the service first before making any commitment to attend regular sessions. Please note that most of the providers listed in this sheet allow clients to try out a session first, and most of them offer short stays or respite as well as day care.

The Filo Project provides small group day care in hosts' own homes for older people who are socially isolated, most of whom are experiencing symptoms associated with mild to moderate dementia and other challenges of older age. Transport is provided, lunch, activities and conversation. Sessions are largely dictated by the preferences of group members. All hosts are carefully selected and receive ongoing training and supervision. They are subject to an enhanced DBS clearance as well as being trained in Emergency First Aid, Dementia, Moving and Handling and Food Safety.

NB. Help with funding may be available, based on a means test, if you are eligible for social care support or your carer has 'enhanced' eligibility for a break. Torbay Adult Social Care is on (01803) 219700.
